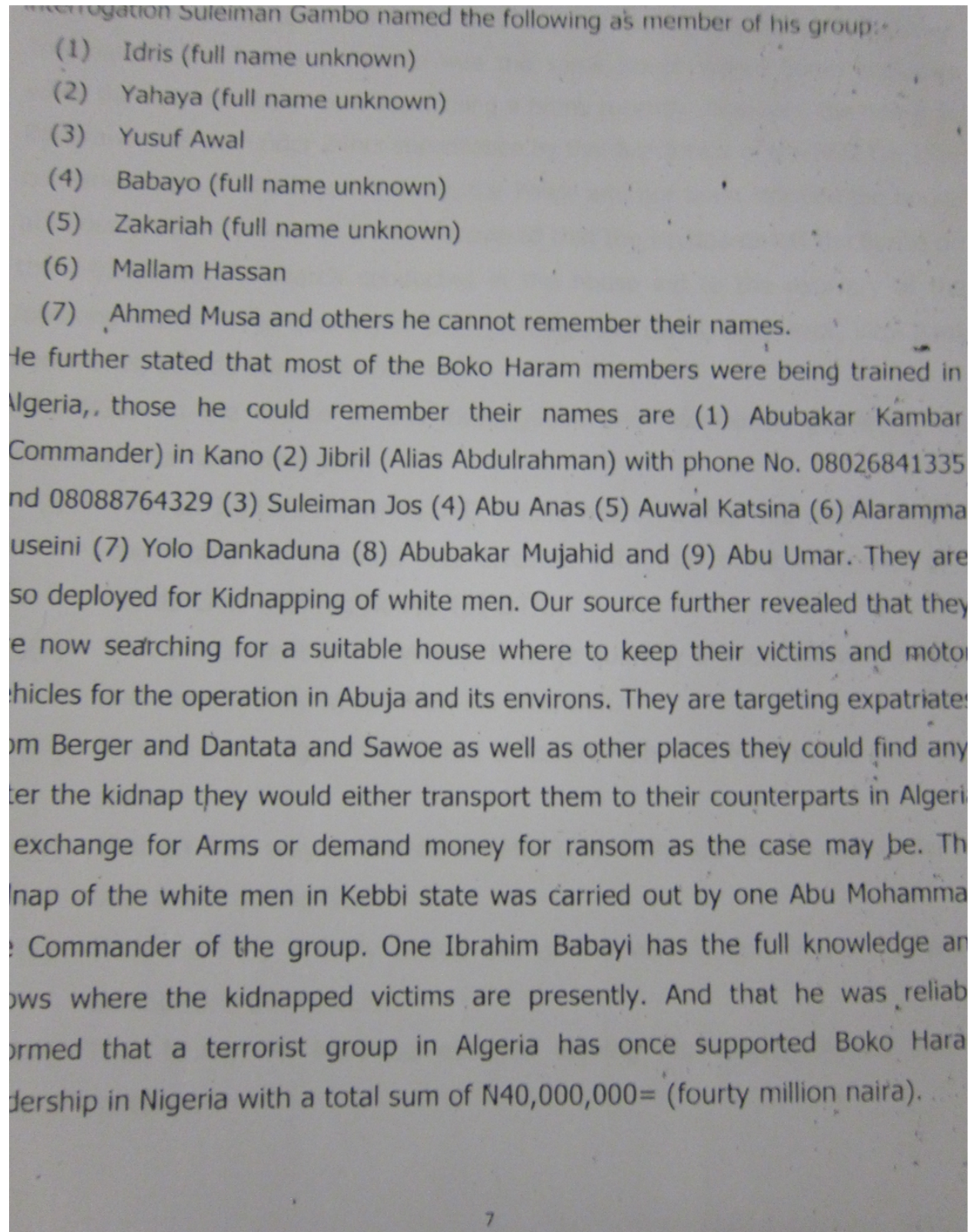


Suleiman Gambo and related case files from Nigerian commissioner of police.



- (vi) that the dreaded Boko Haram sect are responsible for the bombings, killing of innocent People, Robbery and car snatching in the Northern part of the Country as well as illegal importation of arms and ammunition into the Country.
- (vii) That most of their leaders who are mostly resident in Borno, Bauchi, Yobe and Gombe states have relocated to Kano and Kaduna states respectively where they plans and carried out their terrorist attacks on unsuspected individuals and Government establishment.
- (ix) - That the six suspects arrested namely Mohammed Aliyu (Alias Hamza) (2) Abdullahi Ahmed Ibrahim (3) Kyari Ali (4) Tahir (5) Suleiman Gambo (6) Yunusa Ahmed, are all high ranking Boko Haram members who are either resident in Maiduguri Borno state or Gombe state
- x) That Mohammed Aliyu (Alias Hamza) is a close confidence of the National leader of the sect, Alh. Abubakar Shekaw, that during the course of interrogation Mohammed Aliyu (Alias Hamza) claimed that the house at damamawa where the suicide vehicle loaded with bomb was actually occupied by Alh. Abubakar Shekaw that he rented the house in his name as a disguise and that Shekaw and his family were in the house, hence they had to attack the Police to rescue him and his family.
- That the AK47 riffle No. 344048 NPF/UPM/DTR/01/Yobe state, is believed to have been stolen during the 1st attack in Yobe state. G3 riffle No. 69090459 NPF/SNK/G30/Kaduna state, and Lar riffle No. 1676296 NPF SNK/Lar/06/Kaduna, were the riffles from Kaduna state, were believed to have been seized from the Police after robbing First Bank Saminaka, where they shot and killed the two Police men on duty at the Bank.

Record loaded with three assembled bombs, five cylinder, 50 litres Jerrican of petroleum and wire, and one golf Car, were recovered from the suspects.


(xx) That the arrest of the suspects and the recovery of the items listed above is the reason for the recent attack in Yobe and Borno state as a retaliatory measure.

(xxi) That with these arrest and recovery, Kano state is no more a sanctuary for the sect leaders including Abubakar Shekaw.

RECOMMENDATION:- From the above facts and findings, there is prima facie case of Criminal Conspiracy, Belonging to unlawful society, Culpable homicide, Armed Robbery and terrorism has so far been established against the arrested suspects. Information at our disposal indicates that, there is a syndicate that imports arms and ammunitions to the sects from Tchad Republic into Nigeria through Gamboru Ngala in Borno state. Their link man in Tchad Republic is one a Yadawayi, he works in a Foam Factory in Njemnena. He transports the arms and ammunition concealed under goods from Tchad to Nigeria in Trailers to oneammed Khalid (phone No 08034232643, 08127069142) in Gamboru Ngala state and stored in his House (address unknown). The ammunitions are sealed and are further loaded in engine oil gallons as a disguise for ease of transportation to avoid security checks to either Maiduguri or other states. Arms are further concealed under the back seats and the rear doors cover of Golf motor cars. However, efforts are on top gear towards arresting Abubakar Shekaw, a national leader of the sect, who is strongly believed to be either in Kano or Maiduguri. Kabiru Sokoto who is the sponsor of Suleiman Gambo and his Boko Haram terrorist group operating in Sokoto and Kebbi states respectively. While he

Kabiru Sokoto is leading other terrorist group in Okene Kogi state. He responsible for Kabba Police station and Bank Robbery. Also reliable info revealed that One Suleiman, Mutari Kafanchan, Mohammed, and Bashar v to be responsible for the St. Theresa Catholic Church Madala Bombing already on our wanted lists. The team would like to reinterrogate Moham (Alias Hamza) for more information on Abubakar Shekaw.
