Excellence Mr. President. Mr. President, at the request of Colonel Abba Yana I confirm the following points:

My name is Tanguy Moulin-Fournier, a French Citizen residing in Cameroon.

- I am currently in the hands of Jama'atu ahlissunah Lidda awati wal jihad on this day of March 18, 2013, the 28<sup>th</sup> day of our detention.

- I am here with my wife and my four children and my brother.

- Jama'atu ahlissunah Lidda awaTi wal jihad asks for the release of their brothers detained in Cameroonian jails

- Jama'atu ahlissunah Lidda awaTi wal jihad asks for the liberation of their wives and children detained in Nigeria in the states of Borno, Yobe, Adamawa and Kano.
